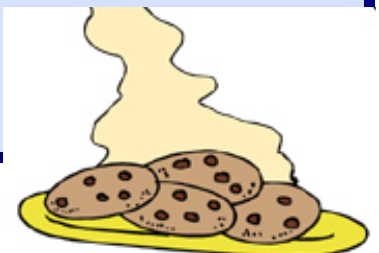
MEETING IN REVIEW

- ◆ Don't forget to bring your fresh baked cookies!! The riders love those cookies!!



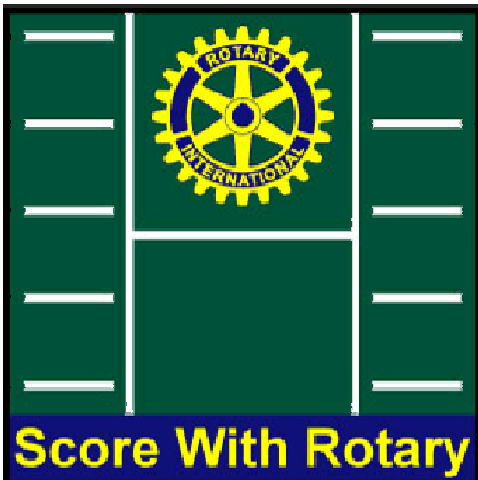
CLUB NEWS

CANYON CLASSIC REMINDERS
