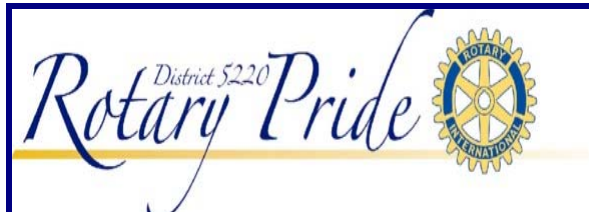

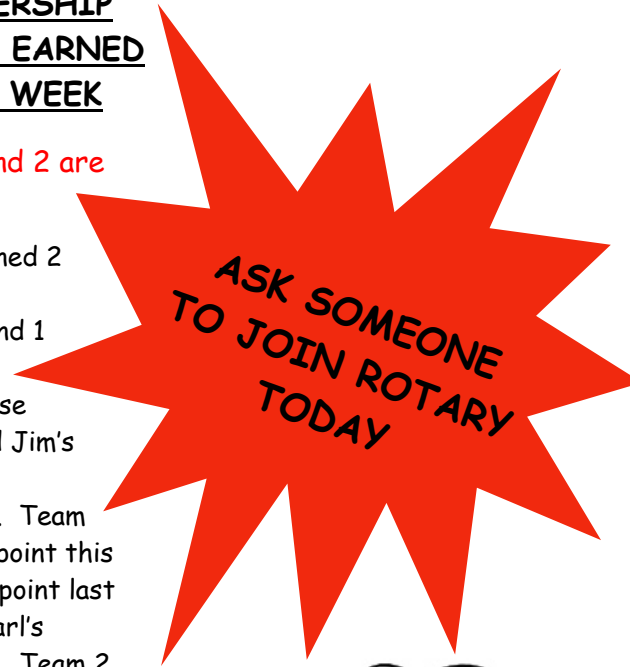

Teams 1 and 2 are tied!

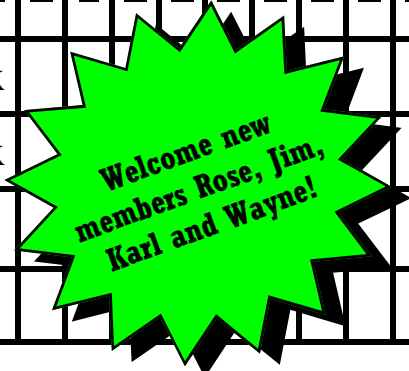

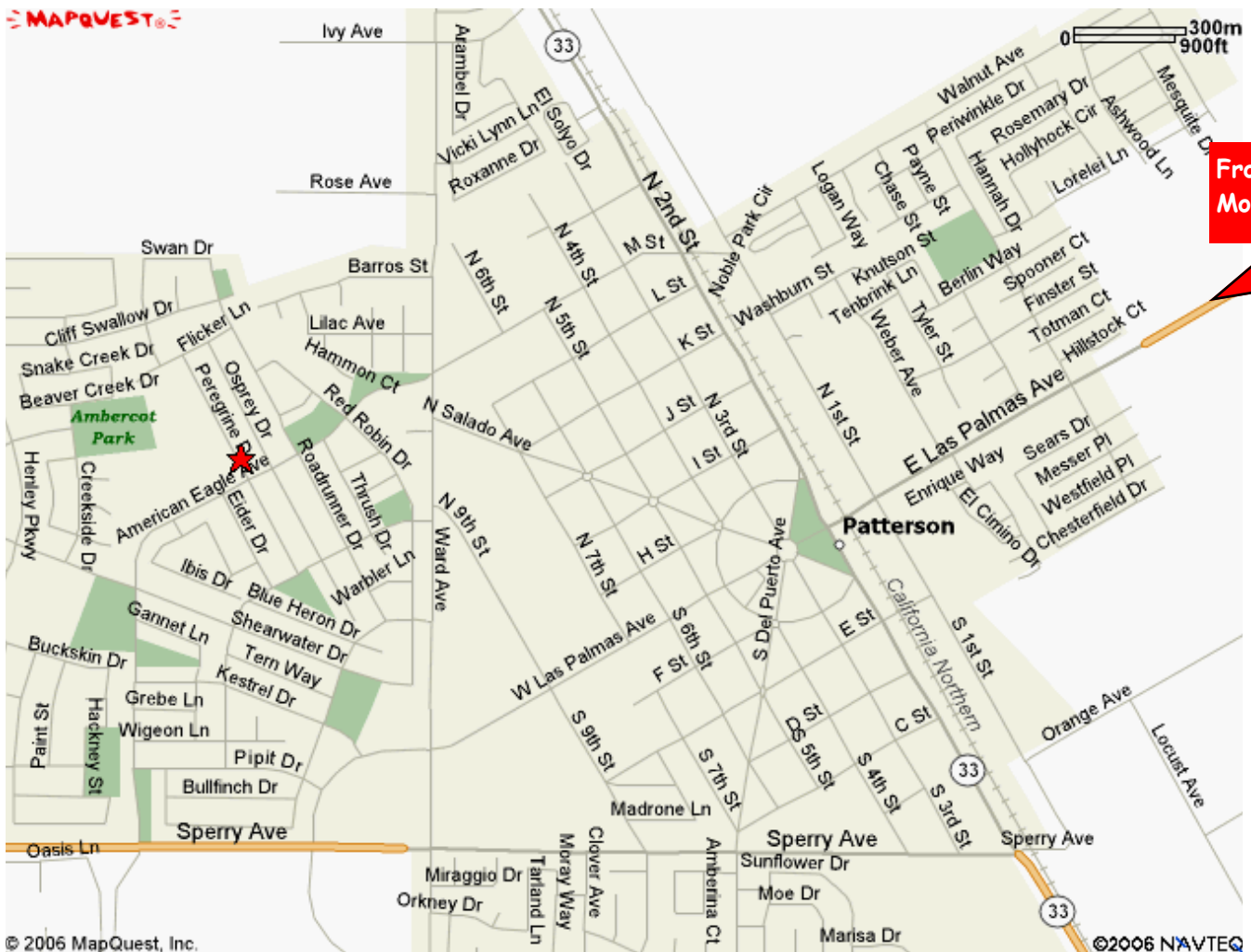


MORE CANYON CLASSIC INFORMATION:

HOW TO GET TO CREEKSIDE MIDDLE SCHOOL
