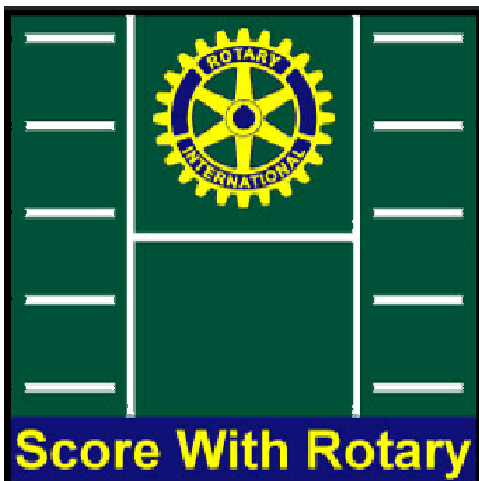
### MEETING IN REVIEW

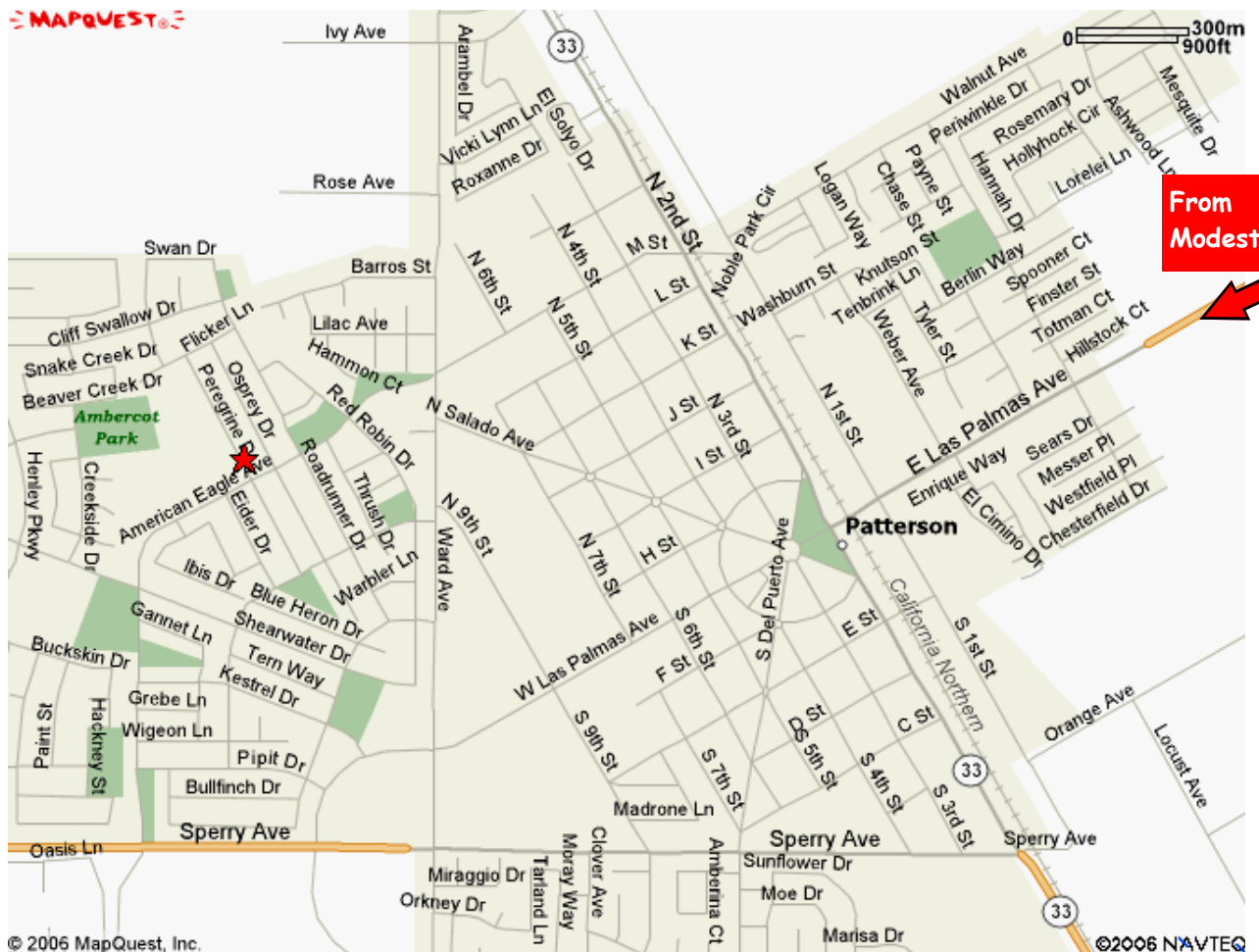
### CANYON CLASSIC UPDATE
